The big picture: The Logistics Managers' Index (LMI) is a diffusion index that measures supply chain conditions. The LMI consists of eight key logistics metrics ranging from inventory levels to transportation utilization. Any number below 50 is indicative of contraction, while any number above 50 is indicative of expansion. Why it matters: The LMI reflects the strength of the overall economy as it measures both upstream and downstream conditions. When the two curves depicted in this chart invert, it signals bad news for freight rates. **Our thoughts:** Though the two curves haven't inverted yet, it suggests the freight market is cooling off.




