

 Week-to-week: the national average price per gallon of diesel is now \$4.389, up 0.011 cents from last week. That national average is \$0.52 lower than it was one year ago. This week's largest change occurred in the Rocky Mountain region where prices increased \$0.106 from \$4.394 to \$4.500. The Midwest region was the only one to see a decrease weekover-week.
